TO: Symetra Life-Appointed Agencies in Washington  
RE: New Requirement for All Applications and Claim Forms

On July 1, 2006, Washington state approved R.C.W. 48.135.080. This statute requires insurers to include the following Washington-specific fraud warning on all applications and claim forms no later than six months after the July 1 effective date:

*"It is a crime to knowingly provide false, incomplete, or misleading information to an insurance company for the purpose of defrauding the company. Penalties include imprisonment, fines, and denial of insurance benefits."*

Updated forms featuring the required fraud warning will be available on or before Jan. 1, 2007, through our [Life Electronic Forms and Applications](#) site or the Sales Center. After Jan. 1, 2007, we will no longer accept applications without the required statement.
